

PRIVACY POLICY

This document under the name "Privacy Policy" aims to protect the data of people using the website <http://hyggemokotow.pl/>.

The website <http://hyggemokotow.pl/> is maintained by Dynamic Development sp. z o.o. with the registered office in Nowa Wola, Lesznowola administrative district at ul. Plonowa 24.

The privacy of our users is very important to us. We encourage you to read this Privacy Policy, so that you can find out:

1. what types of information we obtain and by what means,
2. for what we will use the obtained information,
3. about the right to access information, modify and delete it.

Data Administrator

The administrator of Personal Data collected via www.dynamicdevelopment.pl is Dynamic Development sp. z o.o. with the registered office in Nowa Wola (Lesznowola administrative district) at ul. Plonowa 24 (hereinafter referred to as the Administrator) within the meaning of the Act of 29 August 1997 Act on the Protection of Personal Data (Journal of Laws of 2016, item 922).

We declare that:

- personal data is processed in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act of 29 August 1997 (hereinafter: the Personal Data Protection Act) and the Electronic Services Provision Act of July 18, 2002 (Journal of Laws 2002) No. 144, item 1204, as amended).
- we take special care to protect your interests, and in particular we ensure that the data collected is processed in accordance with the law; is collected for specified, legitimate purposes, and data is not subjected to further processing incompatible with these purposes; substantially correct and adequate in relation to the purposes set out in this privacy policy, in which it is processed and stored in a form enabling the identification of persons they concern, no longer than it is necessary to achieve the purpose of processing.

Types of obtained information

The data collected from you is used only for the purposes that is set out in this Privacy Policy or indicated to the user immediately prior to the acquisition of this data, including in particular the function of a specific form. We collect data such as name, e-mail address, telephone number.

We obtain information through:

- voluntary input of data by the user in forms,
- saving cookies files in user's devices,
- collecting web server logs.

ad 1.

We protect the data of our users, which are collected and processed only for the use of the website <http://hyggemokotow.pl/>. We do not share any data collected via the website <http://hyggemokotow.pl/> with any third parties. Personal data provided through the forms available on the website <http://hyggemokotow.pl/> include, first of all: name, telephone number and email address.

ad 2.

To provide services at the highest possible level and customize content to individual needs and interests of users, we use the so-called cookies (cookies) and system logs.

ad 3.

Web server logs can contain information about technical parameters of the connection and visited subpages. Technical information is primarily: HTTP request time, user IP address, http errors, the website address previously visited by the user (referrer link), information about web browser, which was used. This information is collected only for security purposes and for statistical data on service viewership.

Purpose of collecting information

Data provided by you on the website <http://hyggemokotow.pl/> is used only for the following purposes:

1. providing services related to the functioning of the website,
2. to handle the submitted query

Legal basis

The legal basis for the processing of personal data is:

- the need to fulfill an agreement, you are a Party or take action on your request before its conclusion. This basis refers to data collected through the contact form, available on our website. In this case, providing personal data is necessary to implement on your request a specific activity in accordance with the chosen subject of the inquiry, e.g. if you do not provide us with an email address, we will not be able to give you an answer to the query.
- Your consent to the processing of certain categories of data for a specific purpose, e.g. marketing,
- the need to implement legitimate purposes of the Data Administrator, which are expressed by:
 - website management,
 - adapting its content to your needs and expectations,
 - ensuring the security of your data in cyberspace.

Recipients' data

We do not disclose personal data to companies, organizations or individuals outside of Dynamic Development if one of the following circumstances does not exist:

- The user has given consent to this action

We provide personal data to companies, organizations and individuals outside of Dynamic Development, if the user agrees.

- The recipient is the Web Administrator

On our behalf, the website is managed by the domain administrator (currently Dynamic Development). Then, a specific administrator and representatives of the company providing technical assistance have access to your data collected by the website (such as: name, phone number and e-mail address).

- There are legal reasons

We provide personal data to companies, organizations and individuals outside of Dynamic Development if we believe in good faith that disclosure, use, retention or disclosure of data is justified in connection with:

- striving to meet the requirements of applicable law, regulations, legal processes or legitimate demands of state institutions,
- enforcing the current Terms of Service, including the investigation of potential infringements,
- detecting and preventing fraud, as well as solving other problems related to fraud, security and technical issues,
- protection of property rights or security of the Data Administrator, users of www.dynamicdevelopment.pl and other persons in the manner required or permitted by law.

User Rights

It is worth to know what rights you have in relation to the processing of your personal data:

- You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time and it will result in cessation of processing personal data on the basis of granted consent. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the compliance of the processing of personal data that we have made on the basis of the consent granted prior to its withdrawal.
- You have the right to request removal (right to be forgotten) regarding your personal data from IT systems and files. This right will be exercised by the Administrator, unless the Administrator has the legal obligation to maintain and, at the same time, process the data, despite the right to be forgotten.
- You have the right to access your data (requests for a copy of the data). This right can be exercised personally at the registered office of Dynamic Development, via the contact form or by contacting Dynamic Development.
- You have the right to rectify (update data). This right can be exercised personally at the registered office of Dynamic Development or via the contact form. Please be advised that updating of data will not delete the data before the update, which is connected with the obligation to maintain the integrity of the data processed by the Administrator for a specific purpose.
- You have the right to limit the processing, including appealing against the processing of data by referring to a specific situation. This right can be exercised personally at the registered office of Dynamic Development or via the contact form. Please be advised that the indicated right will be only implemented by the Administrator if the performance of particular activity is not contrary to applicable law, which obliges the Administrator to process data.
- In addition, you have the right to transfer your data from IT systems to a designated entity and to file a complaint to the regulatory office on the activities of the Data Administrator in the processing of personal data.

Security

We make every effort to protect users from unauthorized access, unauthorized modification, disclosure and destruction of information held by Dynamic Development. Especially:

- we use SSL encryption,
- we control our methods of collecting, storing and processing information, including physical security measures, to protect against unauthorized access to the system,
- we only provide access to personal data to employees, contractors and representatives who must have access to them in order to process them for our needs. In addition, under the contract they are obliged to maintain strict confidentiality, and in the event of failure to meet these obligations may suffer consequences, including termination of cooperation.
